The RESCUE RSM contains a directional microphone for noise cancellation, large PTT button and orange programmable button.

Did You Know?

The RESCUE RSM features a headset port to connect a listen-only headset. A listen-only headset redirects the receive audio through the headset, while still transmitting audio through the RSM. This is necessary when in a situation where you don't want audio broadcasted from the RSM.
